- 2000/2001: EUSD files for bankruptcy, state takeover
- - > Community Survey/Focus Group recommendations
 - · Community use of recreation & school facilities
 - Emeryville Youth Services Advisory Committee and Master Plan for Youth
 - Math, Science, Technology Initiative (Emery Ed Fund, EUSD, City of Emeryville, BayCES)
 - > City of Emeryville joint-lease of EUSD facilities
- 2003/2004:
 - > Community input meetings
 - > AC Transit joint-study
 - > K-12 co-located program, joint-use facilities
 - Community schools: more opportunities for youth, adult, family & senior programs
- 2005: City allocation of RDA funds, \$25M

Project Background

- 2008: AY renovation, supporting TODAY's youth, not just tomorrow's
- 2009:
 - > Initial ESS Conceptual study
 - > AB 1080. Skinner
 - Architect/Builder community meetings and selection → Nexus Partners
- 2010: Passage of Measure J
- <u>2011</u>:
 - > Series A bonds, February 2011
 - > QSCB financing opportunity, August 2011 (5 years -> 3 years to initial occupancy)

Project Background

- Community Schools & Joint-Use
 - » Both a place & a set of partnerships between the school & other community resources
 - Integrated focus on academics, health & social services, youth & community development & community engagement
 - Leads to improved student learning, stronger families and healthier communities
 - Schools become centers of the community, open to everyone – all day, every day, evenings and weekends
 - Increase opportunities for physical activity & healthy living by expanding use of school recreational spaces, leverage capital investments, and more
